Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made and entered into on the 24th day of January, 2025 ("Effective Date"), by and between Inspire Eduversity Publications, with its office located in # 50 Sri Mahaveer Nagar, Periyathottam, Kancheepuram – 631501 (hereinafter referred to as "IEP"), and Tagore College of Arts and Science, located at CLC Works Road, Chromepet, Chennai - 600044 (hereinafter referred to as the "Institution").

Whereas, IEP is a non-profit association with various programs, funded by government and corporate entities, which are offered free of charge to learners across the education spectrum.

Whereas, the Institution is a premier institution with the following details; And whereas, the parties seek to collaborate and work in partnership to mutually complement their strengths and jointly enhance the capacity of learners through one or more programs managed by IEP;

Now, therefore, this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") witnesses the following:

1. Term and Termination: This MoU is valid for an initial term of three (3) year, starting from 24th January 2025. It may be extended for additional periods, as mutually agreed upon by the parties. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a minimum of 30 days' notice to the other party. The MoU will be deemed terminated at the end of the notice period, or after the completion of all ongoing activities, whichever is later, ensuring that the beneficiaries (learners and teachers) are not adversely impacted.

2. Duration/ Term of the MOU: The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto. This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 3 years from the date of signing i.e. up to 23rd January, 2028. The validity of this MOU shall be extended sufficiently early for further periods/batches on mutual agreement by the parties to the MOU. This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and implementation of the MOU would be monitored half yearly.

3. Non-binding Nature of the MoU: This MoU is non-binding on either party. Both parties are collaborating with each other out of mutual goodwill and for the benefit of the learners.

4. Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for Program Coordination: Both parties shall appoint a designated person to serve as the single point of contact for all matters related to the program rollout. While individual learners and teachers may interact with corresponding trainers, mentors, advisors, and peers during the program, all matters pertaining to the execution of this MoU shall be handled by the SPOC.

5. Program Calendar: The SPOCs from both parties will collaborate with their respective internal stakeholders to develop a calendar for the program(s) rollout at the beginning of each quarter. This calendar will then be synchronized and published for everyone to use.

6. Responsibilities of IEP and/or its program sponsors/partners: The IEP will conduct orientation sessions for learners and educators at a mutually agreed-upon schedule to onboard them into the program(s). These sessions may take the form of webinars, workshops, or technology boot camps, aimed at assisting learners in achieving their career goals. These programs will be organized regularly according to a set schedule and will be conducted by IEP team members, program sponsors, or external stakeholders, as appropriate.

7. **Interaction with Industry Experts:** IEP will invite industry experts (subject to availability) to the Institute to engage with students through seminars, workshops, and FDPs.

8. **Assessments:** IEP will conduct assessments, as required, for its programs before certification by IEP and/or its industry partners and/or participating private or government agencies."

9. **Update:** IEP will keep the institution's management informed about the progress of the program(s)

Responsibilities of the Institution:

a. **Learner Identification:** The institute will identify learners, volunteers, and instructors who may participate in one or more programs offered by the IEP.

b. **Support with Orientation Sessions:** The institute will assist the IEP in conducting orientation sessions for all stakeholders.


c. **Support with Attendance:** The institute will ensure that program participants actively engage in their chosen programs, with a minimum attendance requirement as agreed upon by both parties.


d. **Support with Assessments:** The institute will ensure that on-site assessments are proctored and professionally managed.


e. **Support for Publication:** The institute will assist both staff members and students in publishing articles and books, and will also publish a souvenir magazine.


f. **Support with Writing:** The institute will help students by teaching article writing and enhancing their communication skills.
