Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on February 4, 2025 (the "Effective Date"), by and between Global Edushiksha Skill Academy (A Division of IEP), with its office located in # 50 Sri Mahaveer Nagar, Periyathottam, Near Pachaiyappa's College for men, Kancheepuram – 631501. (hereinafter referred to as "GESA"), and Tagore College of Arts and Science, located at CLC Works Road, Chromepet, Chennai-600044. (hereinafter referred to as the "Institution").

Whereas, GESA is a non-profit organization offering multiple programs funded by government and corporate entities, which are made available free of charge to learners across various educational sectors.

Whereas, the Institution is a prestigious organization with the following details; and whereas, both parties wish to collaborate in a partnership to complement each other's strengths and work together in building the capacity of learners through one or more of the programs managed by GESA:

Now therefore, this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called "MoU") witnesses following.

1. **Term and Termination:** This MoU is valid for an initial term of three (3) year, starting from February 4, 2025. The term may be extended by mutual agreement of both parties. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a minimum of thirty (30) days' notice to the other party. The MoU will be considered terminated either at the end of the notice period or upon the completion of any ongoing activities, whichever occurs later, to ensure that the beneficiaries (learners and teachers) are not negatively impacted.
2. **Duration/ Term of the MOU:** The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto. This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 3 years from the date of signing i.e. up to 3rd February, 2028. The validity of this MOU shall be extended sufficiently early for further periods/batches on mutual agreement by the parties to the MOU.

This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and implementation of the MOU would be monitored half yearly.

3. **Non-binding Nature:**

This MoU is non-binding on either party. Both parties are collaborating in good faith and for the benefit of the learners.

4. **Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for Program Coordination:**

Both parties shall appoint a designated person who will serve as the primary point of contact for all matters related to program implementation. While individual learners and teachers may interact with respective trainers, mentors, advisors, and peers during the program, all matters concerning the execution of this MoU will be handled by the designated SPOC.

5. **Program Calendar:**

The SPOCs from both parties will collaborate with their respective internal stakeholders to develop a program calendar for each quarter. This calendar will be synchronized between the parties and published for the benefit of all participants.

6. **Responsibilities of GESA and/or its Program Sponsors/Partners:**

GESA will conduct orientation sessions for learners and educators, scheduled by mutual agreement, to onboard them into the program(s). These sessions may take the form of webinars, workshops, or technology boot camps designed to assist learners with their career goals. These programs will be organized regularly according to a predetermined schedule and conducted by GESA team members, program sponsors, or external stakeholders as appropriate.

7. Interaction with Industry Experts:

GESA will facilitate interactions with industry experts (subject to availability) through seminars, workshops, or Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) at the Institute to engage students and provide valuable insights.

8. Assessments:

GESA will conduct necessary assessments for its programs before issuing certifications, in collaboration with its industry partners or any participating private or government agencies.

9. Updates:

GESA will keep the institution's management informed of the progress and status of the program(s) regularly.

Responsibilities of the Institution:

a. **Learner Identification:** The institution will identify learners, volunteers, and instructors who may participate in one or more programs offered by GESA.

b. **Support for Orientation Sessions:** The institution will assist GESA in conducting orientation sessions for all stakeholders.


c. **Support for Attendance:** The institution will ensure that program participants actively engage in the chosen programs, maintaining a minimum attendance level as agreed upon by both parties.


d. **Support for Assessments:** The institution will ensure that assessments conducted on-site are properly proctored and professionally managed.


e. **Skill Development Program:** GESA agrees to offer skill development programs, both offline and online, for staff members, and to conduct Faculty Development Programs (FDP) and Staff Orientation and Development Programs (SODP).

f. **Awards for Students and Faculty:** GESA will honour awards for both students and faculty members.
